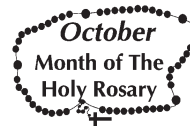
PROPAGATION OF FAITH

October Rosary Devotions

When our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Bernadette in 1858, and to the children of Fatima in 1917, her constant request for the visionaries to deliver to the people was ***"to pray, pray, and pray,"*** especially the Rosary. These apparitions took place when the world was at war and in crisis. Once again we are at the threshold of a war that will surpass all wars that we have seen-the war between the forces of good and evil. Economic and spiritual circumstances and threats of terrorism are at epidemic proportions today. Families have become dysfunctional, broken, and lacking in faith. Children have fallen under the spell of electronic cults and secularism. Jobs and homes are lost.
