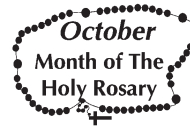

October Rosary Devotions

When our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Bernadette in 1858, and to the children of Fatima in 1917, her constant request for the visionaries to deliver to the people was ***“to pray, pray, and pray,”*** especially the Rosary. These apparitions took place when the world was at war and in crisis. Once again we are at the threshold of a war that will surpass all wars that we have seen: the war between the forces of good and evil. Economic and spiritual circumstances and threats of terrorism are at epidemic proportions today. Families have become dysfunctional, broken, and lacking in faith. Children have fallen under the spell of electronic cults and secularism. Jobs and homes are lost. Illnesses have been felt in every family. Are you ready to pray to Mary and her Son, Jesus for assistance? Respond to her plea ***“to pray”*** and come on the **Wednesdays of October** to recite the Rosary and receive the blessing of her Son Jesus at Benediction, in the **Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph at 7P.M. October 22nd, and 29th.** Coffee and refreshments will follow each devotion service in the Chapel Room. **This is a family event for young and old.** *Our Lady of the Holy Rosary, pray for us.*
