

First Friday Devotion

Last Sunday, our Holy Father, Pope Francis, celebrated the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass in Revolution Square in Havana, Cuba. This is a where communist country public religious celebrations, especially Catholic celebrations are seldom permitted. For the past 60 years since the revolution, a huge picture of the Sacred Heart of Jesus still hangs in a prominent spot overlooking the square. The picture reminds people daily that Jesus is with them and it has helped to sustain the faith of the people of Cuba who have great private devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. So far, we have the freedom to express our faith openly. Monday through Friday, over 100,000 vehicles pass each way by our church. Over the main entrance to our upper church stands a six foot statue of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. with one hand raised in blessing and the other pointing to the great furnace of mercy and love that pours out from His Sacred Heart. Exercising our Freedom of Religion and celebrating who we are as bearers of the name of this great "Heart of Love", make the time this First Friday, October 2nd and begin your personal devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 AM. Exposition and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will follow Mass until 12 Noon. All are welcome to come and make a visit with Jesus. His REAL PRESENCE, exposed on the altar during this The rosary is prayed each hour on the halftime. hour and at noon the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus will be prayed. At 7:00PM, a service with the praying of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Scripture reading and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will bring the day to a close. All services will take place in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph. The chapel is air conditioned and handicapped accessible.
