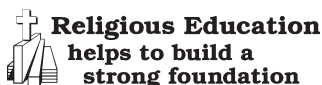

Eucharistic Adoration  **July 1st**, begins the weekend celebration of the **240th Anniversary** of the birth of our nation on July 4th. It is also the **First Friday** of the month, the day we honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus. What a wonderful gift God has granted to our nation. But as Benjamin Franklin was asked as he left Independence Hall on that **July 4th 1776**, "What did we vote for?" His reply was "A Republic, If we can keep it." Many ideas have come and gone since that day, and many of our rights and freedoms are being threatened and taken away. Do you think it is time for us pray? As we light our bonfires and grills, watch our fireworks, and celebrate this holiday, let us not forget how much God has blessed us as a nation. Join us for **Mass at 7AM on Friday, July 1st**. Exposition and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will follow until **12 Noon**. Before you go off to celebrate come and spend a few minutes, in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. The rosary will be prayed each hour on the half hour, Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament and the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy will take place at **12 Noon**. Evening Prayer at 7 PM will **NOT** take place this month but will resume on August 5th. All devotions will take place in the Upper Church during the Jubilee Year of God's Mercy.
