
## **FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION**

Monday, August 15<sup>th</sup> we celebrate the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. A Mass for this Holy Day will be celebrated in the **UPPER CHURCH** at 7:00 A.M. as we continue the celebration of the Year of Mercy. This year it is not a Holy Day of obligation but the faithful are encouraged to celebrate this solemnity.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is a dogma of faith, believed by all Catholics, that at the end of her earthly life Mary was taken body and soul up to heaven. This dogma was promulgated in the papal bull (decree) "Munifficentissimus Deus" by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950 as an infallible teaching of the Church. It states: "the Immaculate Mother of God, Mary ever Virgin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven." In this definition no position is taken on the disputed question on whether Mary actually died, nor are any historical details given. Pope Pius XII declared the faith of the Church that Mary, in the fullness of her historical personality lives now in union with the risen Christ.
