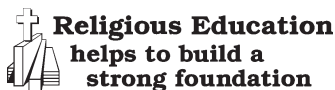

**ALL SAINTS DAY/ALL SOULS MEMORIAL**

Tuesday, November 1<sup>st</sup> is All Saints Day, a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be celebrated in the upper church on Monday evening at 7:00 and Tuesday morning at 7:00.

Wednesday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> is All Souls Day. On this day the church remembers and prays for all the faithful departed and continues with eight more days of Masses. It is our privilege to pray for the Holy Souls who have gone before us, marked with the sign of faith, that they arrive home in heaven. Our prayers and especially the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass beg God to forgive and remove any temporal stain of sin that our loved ones may have taken with them in death.

On Friday, November 4<sup>th</sup> a prayer service will be held in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph at 7 p.m. The names of all those who died this past year will be read aloud. The service will end with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.
