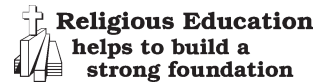


WELCOME!!! We are happy that you are with us today to celebrate your thanks for the gift of Christ in your heart!! If you are a visitor, we hope that you have a prayerful time with our parish family. If you are new to our parish or haven’t been with us for a while, **we welcome you with open arms.** If you have not yet registered as parishioners, we hope that you will take a minute to complete a registration form and either send it to the rectory or drop it into the collection basket.

IMPORTANT!

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that we have a **“PRAYER INTENTION BASKET”** located in the vestibule in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph? Paper and pen are available for you to write out your particular prayer request (**no names please**), and each morning, Monday thru Friday, your intention is prayed for by our Rosary Prayer Group after the 7:00 AM morning Mass. During the months and also the First Friday devotions the petitions are burned and new intentions are collected for the following month. If you have a special need to be prayed for please stop by the Chapel or call the rectory **(508)-634-5435** and they will pass it on to Deacon Pat.



Registration forms have been mailed to all families. The registration fee for 2017-2018 is \$125 for the first child and \$100 for each additional child. An early bird discount of \$10 per child may be deducted by families who register by **June 30th**. Registration forms are posted on the Parish website. Families will be contacted in August about class schedules.

Additional information current Grade 1 students—the grade 2 sacramental program consists of 2 parts—regular CCD classes and sacramental retreats designed to prepare the children for their First Penance and First Communion. A separate letter detailing the grade 2 sacramental program and retreat dates will be sent out in the next few weeks.

Additional information for current Grade 8 students—The Grade 9 Confirmation Preparation Program meets on Sunday evenings from 6-8 p.m., generally twice a month. A calendar of class dates will be distributed at the parents meeting in the fall.

*****Children who will be attending a Catholic school and entering 2nd, 9th or 10th grade in the fall must also register for the sacramental preparation retreats and classes*****

Additional information for all current Grade 9 students—Grade 10 students attend an overnight retreat as part of the Confirmation preparations. The retreat is held at the Betania II Center in Medway with the students from both Sacred Heart and St Mary’s parishes. The retreats are coordinated by Limitless Youth Ministry adult volunteers and several dates are offered each school year. A parent meeting will be held in August at St. Mary’s. We will pass that date on to you once the meeting is scheduled. Wishing you all a very wonderful summertime.
