The Catechism of the Catholic Church 1328-1332 refers to many different names for the Eucharistic Celebration we call "The Mass". During the coming weeks of summer, through the weekly bulletin, we will be presenting little 'teachings' on the deeper meaning of **"THE MASS"** as well as an explanation/ understanding of the rituals and gestures during the Mass.. what we do during the Mass, what we say and what we believe. We offer this with the hope that these little 'teachings' will serve as encouragement to look deeper into the richness and beauty of the Catholic Mass and in our faith.

The Mass had its beginning at the Last Supper. The Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke provide us with an account of the night that Jesus instituted the Eucharist and at Mass, to this day, the Priest prays the words of Jesus". "This is my body which is given up for you, This is the cup of my blood, the blood of the new and lasting covenant. It will be shed for you and for all so that sins may be forgiven. Do this in memory of me. "It is at the Mass where we go and partake of the bread and cup of our Lord... where else would we go?. Next Week: Scripture at Mass.

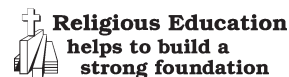
