Children's Liturgy The Children's Liturgy of the Word program has proven extremely successful and is enjoyed by over 20 children each time it is offered. **We are in need of a**

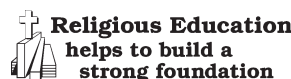

## TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**OCTOBER - First Friday Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.** Friday, October 6, 2017, is the **First Friday** of the month. Traditionally in our parish every First Friday of the month is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. On Friday, our day begins with the celebration of **Mass at 7AM**, in the Chapel of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph followed by exposition and adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament until 12 Noon. The rosary is prayed every hour on the half hour beginning at 7:30 AM. At **12 NOON Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament will take place along with the recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.** All are invited to come anytime during these hours for spiritual enrichment and your personal time with Jesus. **We encourage our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to spend some time in prayer before the REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS** as part of their spiritual development. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus also serves as a reminder for one to receive the Sacrament of Penance (Reconciliation). The Sacrament of Reconciliation may also be requested each day, following morning Mass, by coming to the Sacristy. Confession is also available from 8 AM to 3 PM weekdays (except Thursday) at the rectory or by appointment. Saturday confessions are scheduled 3-3:30 PM in the upper church.

### October Rosary Devotions

When our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Bernadette in 1858 and the children of Fatima in 1917, her constant request to them to deliver the message **“to pray, pray, and pray”** especially the **Rosary**. These apparitions took place when the world was at war and in crisis. Once again we are at the door of a war that will surpass all wars that we have ever seen the war between the forces of good and evil, Spirituality and secularism. Threats of nuclear war and terrorism. Families have become dysfunctional, broken, and lacking in faith. Children have fallen under the spell of electronic cults. The list goes on and on.
